





ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WOODCREEK ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: $\mbox{WOODCREEK}$ ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

A. The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to own or lease, operate and maintain Community Facilities located on and for the benefit of residents of certain real property (the "Property") which is now or hereinafter made subject to a certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and Reservation of Easements for Woodcreek Association, Inc. (the "Declaration"), including all amendments thereto, which is recorded with the Recorder of Clermont County, Ohio at Deed Book 610, Page 229; and, in general, to assist in promoting the establishment and maintenance of a uniform plan for the development of the Property and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents within.

- B. In implementation of the above purposes, the Association may:
 - (1) exercise of all of the powers, privileges and authority and perform all of the duties and obligations

of the Association as set forth in the Declaration (said Declaration being incorporated herein as if set forth at length), including, without limitation, such powers as are hereinafter set forth;

- (2) fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association;
- (3) acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association;
- (4) borrow money for the purpose of constructing, equipping, improving and maintaining Community Facilities, and in aid thereof, mortgage the Community Facilities; provided that any such action may only be taken in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Declaration;
- (5) participate in mergers or consolidations with other nonprofit corporations organized for similar purposes,

provided that any such merger or consolidation shall have 553 the consent of (a) two-thirds (2/3) of the members, and (b) the Developer, if during the Development Period.

- (6) annex additional Community Facilities in accordance with the applicable terms of the Declaration;
- (7) to do any and all things necessary, convenient, or expedient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, and, in general, to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be formed under Chapter 1702 of the Ohio Revised Code.

ARTICLE III

This Corporation is organized as a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 1702 of the Ohio Revised Code. No part of the net earnings or assets of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any of its trustees, officers, members, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

ARTICLE IV

E0501-0834

A. Every Owner of a Parcel subject to the Declaration, meaning the owner of record from time to time, whether one or more persons or entities, of an interest in fee simple, reversion, remainder or leasehold estate of 99 years or more in such Parcel (but not including the Corporation itself), shall be a member of the Corporation and shall be entitled to one vote on each matter properly submitted to the members for each Dwelling Unit located on his Parcel and owned by such member; provided that any member who has had his right or privilege of use and enjoyment of the Community Facilities suspended as provided in the Declaration shall not be entitled to vote during any period in which any such suspension or the Default causing the suspension continues, whichever is longer; and further provided that if a Parcel shall be owned by more than one Owner, such Owners shall be deemed to constitute a single member as to such Parcel for purposes of this Article.

B. A corporation, whether profit or nonprofit, or a partnership may be a member of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V

Trustees need not be members of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI

The place in the State of Ohio where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this Corporation is to be located is in Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio.

ARTICLE VII

The Corporation may be dissolved with the consent of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the Owners and the Developer, if during the Development Period. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Corporation shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Corporation was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed and assigned to any nonprofit corporation, association, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.

ARTICLE VIII

The terms "Association", "Board", "Developer", "Development Period", "Dwelling Unit", "Owner", "Parcel",

"Property", and "Community Facilities" shall have the same definition for purposes of these Articles as contained in the Declaration.

ARTICLE IX

Amendment of these Articles shall require the consent of two-thirds of the members, and, if during the Development Period, the Developer.

ARTICLE X

In the event of any inconsistency between the provisions of these Articles and the provisions of the Declaration, the provisions of the Declaration shall govern.
